**To be granted a GRE fee waiver, you must be either an enrolled college senior or an unenrolled college graduate \* and fall into the following categories:**

1. You must be a United States Citizen or resident alien.
2. You must be eligible for financial aid with:
  - a. a parental contribution of \$1,400 or less for the senior year (Dependent student)
  - b. a total family contribution of \$1,800 or less for the senior year (Self-supporting/independent student)

\* An applicant who is an unenrolled college graduate must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine eligibility. Once the applicant receives the Student Aid Report (SAR), he/she should bring it to the financial aid office to see if he/she is eligible for a fee waiver.
